
# **Trans Community: Poverty and Employment**


## **Employment**



- 43% report they are underemployed.
- 39% feel they lost a job because of their Trans identity.
- 92% kept their identity secret out of fear of being fired.
- 46% feel they were not selected for a position, in which they were qualified, because they are a member of the Trans community.

#### Income

The low income measure for a single person household in the Simcoe/Muskoka area is \$19, 930/year.



86% of trans individuals surveyed say their income is below the \$19, 930 low income measure.

### **Barriers**

Most Trans respondents experience gender-classifying identification as an obstacle to employment.

#### Other Obstacles:

- legal 8 medical costs associated with transitioning,
- length of time it takes to make all legal name and gender changes.
- lack of accessible, affordable transportation,
- applications and other documentation because of references to gender.



### **Medical**

71% of respondents say being a member of the Trans community has limited their access to medical, mental health services or other health and wellness services.
